



Women in Motion of High Point, an initiative of The United Way of Greater High Point, brings local women together to promote leadership, professional success, personal wellness, and financial independence.

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We aim to strengthen community businesses and organizations. At the same time, we continue to create strong programming that will help women in the workplace to encourage economic and professional growth, leading to additional leadership in our communities.

We are planning the curriculum for 2023/2024 and are seeking vision investors who share our vision and goals for our community women. The L. Paul Brayton Family established a women’s initiative fund in 2015 to benefit women in High Point and surrounding communities in honor of Paul Brayton’s late wife, Gwendolyn Kay Brayton. Extensive research about the needs of women in our community was performed by GRAMERCY Research Group. The research results provided the foundation and development of Women in Motion and our programming. Much of the information learned from our original research remains consistent, while other areas continue to emerge as areas of focus based on the current needs in our community. Therefore, we continue to regularly re-evaluate, update and shift programming and program topics.



Our areas of focus are:

Education: Women need additional education to help them negotiate and advocate for themselves.

Mentorship: Women need better systems for networking to promote growth in each other.

Resources: Women, especially women small business owners, expressed a need to tap into resources that already exist in the community to increase their professional and business success.

Wellness: Women seek to balance personal wellness and professional success in conjunction with professional and family demands.

This program consists of workshops and seminars that strengthen the education and skills women need to improve, organize, and create success in their lives.

KITTY CONGDON MENTORING SERIES

The Kitty Congdon Mentoring Series is an annual signature women’s mentoring program. This program introduces women in leadership to the key components of mentoring other women and growing their own skills while doing so.



The annual Women's Summit is a day-long event focused on elevating women to the next level in their personal and professional lives. Women begin to imagine their full potential and take steps to move towards elevated goals.

Networking Events

Women in Motion hosts networking events and meet-ups to enhance community and connection among our members and guests. These events are open to everyone in and around our community.

Grants

A portion of membership dues are allocated to our annual grants campaign, where our members vote on how we give back and continue impacting our community. Programs must primarily serve women in the greater High Point community and pertain to one or more of Women in Motion’s four identified areas of need.
